1. 1 large box of tissues and one box antibacterial wipes
 2. 2 boxes of 16 Crayola thin crayons
 3. Personal supply of #2 *sharpened* pencils & erasers (1 dozen)
 4. 1 pencil case with zipper
 5. 1 pair Fiskar pointed scissors, child size
 6. 1 pack *non-colored* glue sticks
 7. 1 small plastic supply box (8x5.5)
 8. 1 bottle of waterless hand sanitizer (at least 8 oz.)
